We then continue to the Tilajari Resort, where for three days we explore lush rainforest, marvel at the majestic Arenal Volcano, and relax in soothing natural hot springs. Our adventure ends with three days in the mystical Talamanca Mountains, where we'll explore Cloud Forest. Here, amidst the misty canopies, we'll seek out the magnificent Resplendent Quetzal in its nesting grounds—a truly awe-inspiring sight.

Day 1: Monday, May 11

Bougainvillea Hotel





Upon arrival at San José International Airport (SJO), we will transfer to the Bougainvillea Hotel, a tranquil retreat set on 10 acres of award-winning botanical gardens. Conveniently located just 30 minutes from the airport, this charming haven is the perfect setting to begin our adventure.

In the evening, we will gather at the hotel's restaurant to review the itinerary and prepare for the next day's activities.

We depart in the morning for Lirio Lodge. Along the way, we will cross Braulio Carrillo National Park—one of Costa Rica's largest and most diverse protected areas, spanning 50,000 hectares of pristine rainforest. Our journey continues to the Pacuare Reserve, a remote and breathtaking destination on the Caribbean coast, accessible only by boat. Lirio Lodge sits just across from the reserve, which is recognized as the fourth most important nesting site for Leatherback Sea Turtles in the world. For the next two nights, we will immerse ourselves in the beauty of the rainforest and secluded beaches, with an opportunity for a night outing to search for nesting Leatherback Sea Turtles.





We return to the lodge for lunch, followed by an afternoon hike along the reserve's trails, immersing ourselves in the untouched wilderness.

After breakfast, we will depart for the Tilajari Resort. Upon arrival, we will enjoy lunch in this enchanting natural sanctuary, where stunning landscapes and diverse wildlife create a serene retreat. Situated along the banks of the San Carlos River, Tilajari offers a tranquil escape to the peaceful beauty of Costa Rica's northern lowlands.

In the afternoon, we'll take a walk through the resort's gardens. This area provides excellent opportunities to spot toucans, macaws, parrots, tanagers, woodcreepers, and many other tropical bird species. Keep an eye out for the resort's abundant resident sloths and iguanas, which make their home in this biodiverse haven.

Bogarin Trail



Morning birdwatching at Tilajari's bird feeders. More than 20 species of birds visit these fruit feeders. Enjoy a fresh cup of Costa Rican coffee as you watch the colorful array of feathered visitors.

After a delicious breakfast, we'll head to the town of La Fortuna, next to the awe-inspiring Arenal Volcano. Our first stop here will be the famous Bogarin Trail, a birdwatcher's paradise and a favorite for nature lovers.

After a hearty lunch at a local restaurant, we'll visit a Cocoa Plantation. Discover the fascinating process of chocolate production, from the cultivation of the cocoa fruit to the final product. You'll also learn about the origins of vanilla. Both chocolate and vanilla come from the lush tropical rainforest. Can you imagine a world without them?




Early morning birdwatching on the resort grounds.

After breakfast, we will depart to Talamanca Mountains. On the way we will stop at Pierella Gardens, a remarkable grassroots conservation project created by a local family. This sanctuary is a haven for birds and wildlife, featuring a variety of species, including rare finds like the Redthroated Ant-Tanager. Beyond birds, the gardens are home to monkeys, sloths, basilisk lizards, and other fascinating wildlife. After Pierella, we will continue on our way to Savegre Lodge. Afternoon arrival at Savegre Lodge.

After breakfast, we will board the hotel's Land Rovers and ascend to an ancient oak forest at the top of the mountain range. From there, we will embark on a leisurely hike down to the lodge, immersing ourselves in the beauty of the high-altitude cloud forest.

Along the way, we will encounter unique bird species, towering ferns, and a diverse array of flora and fauna characteristic of this region.

In the afternoon, we will stroll in the hotel's gardens and visit a local bird feeding station that attracts a plethora of colorful tropical birds.






Day 10: Wed, May 20
