Costa Rica Green Sea Turtle



Our annual journey to witness Green Sea Turtles nesting in Tortuguero is a longtime favorite.

The adventure begins with a night at the beautiful Bougainvillea Hotel in San José, a perfect place to relax and settle in. From there, we head to the Arenal Volcano region, where we spend three nights at the stunning Arenal Observatory Lodge. During our stay, we explore the rainforest within the lodge's private preserve, enjoy a delicious chocolate tour at a local cocoa plantation, and unwind in the soothing volcanic hot springs.

Next, we travel to Tortuguero, a remote and magical destination accessible only by boat or plane. We will stay for two nights at Manatus Lodge, nestled in the lush tropical surroundings. By day, we explore the rich biodiversity of Tortuguero National Park by boat, and by night, we hope to witness the unforgettable sight of Green Sea Turtles nesting along the beach.

From Tortuguero, we take a private charter flight back to San José, where our bus and driver will be waiting to take us to our final destination: the Talamanca Mountain Range, the highest in Costa Rica. We conclude our journey with two peaceful nights at the cozy Savegre Lodge, exploring cloud forests and hoping to spot the magnificent Resplendent Quetzal, one of the region's most iconic birds.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to San Jose

Arrive at Bougainvillea Hotel. Explore 10 acres of lush botanical gardens.

Day 2: Arenal Observatory Lodge

Departure to Arenal Observatory Lodge. Afternoon rainforest hike.

Day 3: Arenal Volcano

Exploration of the Arenal Observatory gardens and private rainforest preserve.

Day 4: Arenal Volcano

Visit a local cocoa plantation for a chocolate tour, followed by an afternoon soak in hot springs.

Day 5: Manatus Lodge

Travel by bus and boat to Tortuguero National Park. Night outing to see nesting sea turtles.

Day 6: Tortuguero National Park

Visit local Tortuguero village. Boat tour of Tortuguero National Park.

Day 7: Savegre Lodge

Local flight to San Jose and scenic drive to Savegre Lodge.

Day 8: Talamanca Mountains

Morning hike through an ancient oak forest and cloud forest. Afternoon at leisure to enjoy hotel spa and scenery.

Day 9: Transfer to San Jose Airport





Day 1: Friday, June 11


Arrival in San Jose

Upon arrival at San Jose International Airport (SJO), we will be transferred to the Bougainvillea Hotel.

Set among 10 acres of lush, award-winning botanical gardens, this comfortable haven, just 30 minutes from the airport, is an ideal location to start our adventure in Costa Rica.

We will gather in the evening at the hotel restaurant for a welcome dinner and to go over the itinerary and the next day's activities.

Day 2: Saturday, June 12

Arenal Volcano



After breakfast, our private bus will take us on a 3-hour drive to reach the luxurious Arenal Observatory Lodge, nestled among gorgeous gardens at the base of one of the most iconic active volcanoes in Costa Rica.

In addition to the spectacular volcano, the tropical birds, monkeys, sloths, and other animals that live in this majestic landscape make this an unforgettable destination.

Night hike to the local frog pond in search of red-eyed tree frogs and other creatures.




Day 3: Sunday, June 13

Arenal Observatory

Early morning bird watching at our lodge's bird feeders, using tropical fruit to draw many species. After breakfast, we will explore the gardens, trails, and waterfall of the hotel's private reserve.

The Arenal Observatory Lodge is a worldwide destination for nature lovers and bird watchers, with great chances to see howler monkeys, white-faced capuchin monkeys, spider monkeys, toucans, and other tropical wildlife.



Day 4: Monday, June 14

Arenal Volcano



Early morning nature walk on the lodge's trails, followed by breakfast.

Then we will depart for a local cocoa plantation to learn about this magical plant and the chocolate-making process.

Lunch at a local restaurant with the opportunity to taste some of the world's finest chocolate.

After lunch, we will visit the Eco-Thermals Hot Springs and soak to our heart's content in the natural springs surrounded by scenery and sounds of the rainforest.

Day 5: Tuesday, June 15

Tortuguero



After breakfast, our bus will take us on a 3-hour drive through the countryside, followed by a boat ride through rivers and canals surrounded by tropical rainforests. Lunch upon arrival at Manatus Lodge.

Afternoon walk through the village of Tortuguero and visit the Caribbean Conservation Corporation sea turtle research station.

Night outing to observe nesting green sea turtles. Tortuguero is the most important nesting beach for Caribbean green sea turtles. This 18-mile beach can host up to 2,500 nesting females on a peak night!




Early morning boat outing to explore the rainforest of Tortuguero National Park. Our open canopy boats will allow for maximum visibility of the surrounding rainforest, with great chances to see and photograph howler monkeys, spider monkeys, three-toed sloths, and several species of toucans.

We will return to our lodge for lunch, followed by an afternoon hike in the Tortuguero National Park primary rainforest.

Day 6: Wed, June 16

Tortuguero



Talamanca Mountains



After breakfast, we will take a short boat ride to the Tortuguero airport, where we will take a 40-minute flight to San Jose. There, our driver will be waiting to take us on a 2.5-hour drive up the Talamanca Mountains, the tallest mountain range in Costa Rica.

Our destination, Savegre Lodge, is a family-owned lodge with its protected cloud forest preserve located along the bank of the Savegre River. This marvelous location, surrounded by cloud forests and orchards, offers trails that lead to cascading waterfalls. Here, it's usually possible to see the famous Resplendent Quetzal, an iconic bird idolized by the ancient Mayan culture.

Day 8: Friday, June 18

Cloudforest



After breakfast, we will board the hotel's Land Rovers and head to an ancient oak forest at the top of the mountain range. From there, we will take a leisurely hike back down to the lodge.

Along the way, we will encounter high-altitude bird species, giant ferns, and other species typical of this region.

We will spend the afternoon at leisure with the option for a walk into town or staying at the lodge and enjoying the hotel amenities, which include a great spa, cozy pub, and hot tubs.
