Join us to explore three of Costa Rica's most iconic and biodiverse regions on the Caribbean slope of the country.

This unforgettable experience includes the chance to witness the nesting of giant Leatherback Sea Turtles along the Caribbean coast.

As we travel across the country, we'll walk through lush rainforests, explore the slopes of active volcanoes, and search for an incredible variety of tropical wildlife, including toucans, monkeys, sloths and more.

This customized, small-group nature adventure immerses you in the heart of Costa Rica's rich ecosystems—perfect for wildlife lovers, photographers, and curious travelers alike.

On a similar trip in 2025, our group spotted an incredible 32 sloths!



Day 1: Arrival to San Jose

First night at Bougainvillea Hotel.
Welcome dinner at hotel restaurant.

Day 2: Almonds & Corals Hotel

Departure to the South Caribbean coast.
Crossing of Braulio Carrillo National Park

Days 3: Cahuita National Park

Visit to Cahuita National Park. Afternoon at leisure exploring Puerto Viejo town.

Day 4: Lirio Lodge

Departure to Lirio Lodge-Night outing in search of nesting Leatherback sea turtles.

Day 5: Pacuare Preserve

Morning boat tour of the Pacuare reserve.
Afternoon rainforest hike.

Day 6: Arenal Observatory Lodge

Departure to Arenal Observatory Lodge
Visit a local Costa Rican house.

Day 7: Arenal Volcano

Exploration of the Arenal Observatory gardens and private rainforest preserve.
Bird watching.

Day 8: Arenal Volcano

Morning visit to a cocoa plantation and chocolate tour, followed by an afternoon soak in local hot springs.

Day 9: Transfer to San Jose Airport

Day 1: Monday, May 17

Arrival in San Jose



Upon arrival at San Jose International Airport (SJO), we will be transferred to the Bougainvillea Hotel. Set among 10 acres of lush tropical gardens, this comfortable hotel is a great place to start our tropical adventure in Costa Rica.

We will gather in the evening at the hotel restaurant to go over the itinerary and the next day's activities.

Day 2: Tuesday, May 18

Almonds & Corals Hotel

Our morning drive will take us across the Continental Divide and through the vast rainforest of Braulio Carrillo National Park. Descending from the mountains, we will travel through the Caribbean lowlands to reach the Almonds and Corals Boutique Hotel.

The Atlantic coast of Costa Rica is very different from the rest of the country. The people are descendants of Africa and the Caribbean and have a distinct culture, cuisine, and language.

The vegetation of this region is lush, and biodiversity is among the highest in Costa Rica.

Day 3: Wed, May 19

Cahuita National Park

Early morning birding walk through the lodge's trails, followed by breakfast. After breakfast, we will depart for nearby Cahuita National Park.

This park protects 1,106 hectares of pristine coastal rainforest and 22,300 hectares of the marine environment, including the most vibrant coral reefs in Costa Rica.

Our hike through the park will present great bird-watching opportunities and chances to see other wildlife such as sloths, monkeys, and the colorful Golden Eyelash Viper. We will spend the afternoon at leisure with the opportunity to explore the beach and enjoy the hotel amenities.



Day 4: Thursday, May 20

Lirio Lodge



Morning departure to the town of Moin, where we will board a boat that will take us to Lirio Lodge. This remote destination in the middle of the Costa Rican Caribbean coast can only be reached by boat.

Lirio Lodge is in front of the Pacuare Reserve, the fourth most important nesting site for Leatherback Sea Turtles in the world. We will spend the next two nights at Lirio Lodge exploring the beach and the surrounding rainforest.

Day 5: Friday, May 21

Pacuare Reserve



After breakfast, we will board a boat for a morning tour into the Pacuare Reserve.

The reserve is famous for its abundant wildlife and exuberant bird life. Our open-canopy boat will allow for great visibility of the surrounding rainforest.

Return for lunch at the lodge.

After lunch, we will hike the reserve trails.

Day 6: Saturday, May 22

Arenal Volcano

Departure to the Arenal Observatory Lodge.

The Arenal Volcano is one of the most iconic volcanos in Costa Rica, with a constant expulsion of gas from its main crater. In addition to the spectacular volcano, the tropical birds, monkeys, sloths, and other animals living in this majestic landscape make this destination unforgettable.

On our way, we will stop at Pierella Gardens, a local conservation project and butterfly breeding facility. There we will enjoy a typical Costa Rican lunch.

Day 7: Sunday, May 23

Arenal Volcano



Early morning birding on the lodge's trails, followed by breakfast. After breakfast, we depart for a walk through the waterfall trail. Within our hotel's protected area, this is a great location to see abundant wildlife as well as a spectacular waterfall.

Afternoon exploring the gardens and forest at the hotel. We will end the day with a night hike to the famous frog pond, where we are likely to see the amazing red-eye tree frog and several other species.

Day 8: Monday, May 24

Arenal Volcano
